THE CONTRACTOR SHALL FIELD VERIFY EXISTING DIMENSIONS AND DETAILS AFFECTING NEW CONSTRUCTION AND MAKE NECESSARY ADJUSTMENTS PRIOR TO CONSTRUCTION OR ORDERING MATERIALS. ANY ADJUSTMENTS PROPOSED BY THE CONTRACTOR MUST BE APPROVED BY THE ENGINEER. SUCH VARIATIONS SHALL NOT BE CAUSE FOR ADDITIONAL COMPENSATION FOR A CHANGE IN THE SCOPE OF WORK, HOWEVER. THE CONTRACTOR WILL BE PAID FOR THE QUANTITY ACTUALLY FURNISHED BASED UPON THE UNIT PRICE.
- 3. - THE CONTRACTOR SHALL FURNISH AND INSTALL WOOD SIGN SUPPORTS IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 730 OF THE STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS.
- 11. FOR STABILIZATION ALL TYPE III BARRICADES SHALL REQUIRED A MINIMUM OF FOUR SAND BAGS PER BARRICADE.
- 12. EXISTING PAVEMENT MARKINGS SHALL BE TEMPORARILY COVERED PRIOR TO APPLICATION OF THE DECK SURFACE TREATMENT, TO PREVENT THE MATERIAL FROM BEING APPLIED TO THE MARKINGS AND TO PROTECT THE REFLECTIVE PROPERTIES OF THE MARKINGS. THE TEMPORARY COVERING MATERIAL USED SHALL BE SUCH THAT IT WILL NOT AFFECT THE MARKING'S REFLECTIVITY WHEN REMOVED AFTER APPLICATION OF THE DECK SURFACE TREATMENT AND PRIOR TO OPENING TO TRAFFIC.
