THE CONTRACTOR SHALL VERIFY DIMENSIONS AND CONDITIONS IN THE FIELD PRIOR TO CONSTRUCTION AND ORDERING OF MATERIALS.
- 4. THE FOLLOWING HMA MIXTURE REQUIREMENTS ARE APPLICABLE FOR THIS PROJECT:

- 5. THE THICKNESS OF THE HMA MIXTURE SHOWN ON THE PLANS IS THE NOMINAL THICKNESS. DEVIATIONS FROM THE NOMINAL THICKNESS WILL BE PERMITTED WHEN SUCH DEVIATIONS OCCUR DUE TO IRREGULARITIES IN THE EXISTING SURFACE OR BASE ON WHICH THE HMA MIXTURE IS PLACED.
- 6. 'ROAD CONSTRUCTION AHEAD' SIGNS SHALL BE PLACED AT EACH END OF THE PROJECT PLUS THE INTERSECTING SIDEROADS, AND WILL BE CONSIDERED INCLUDED IN THE TRAFFIC CONTROL PAY ITEMS. ALL CONSTRUCTION SIGNS SHALL BE FLUORESCENT ORANGE AND 48" X 48".
- 7. NO OVERNIGHT LANE CLOSURES WILL BE ALLOWED.
- 8. ALL TEMPORARY PAVEMENT MARKING SHALL BE PLACED IN SUCH A MANNER SO AS NOT TO INTERFERE WITH THE PLACEMENT OF PERMANENT PAVEMENT MARKINGS.
