Location	Bar size	No. assemblies required

<u>NOTES</u>

Splicer bars shall be deformed with threaded ends and have a minimum 60 ksi yield strength.

All reinforcement shall be lapped and tied to the splicer bars. Bar splicer assemblies shall be epoxy coated according to the requirements for reinforcement bars. See Section 508 of the Standard Specifications. See approved list of bar splicer assemblies and mechanical splicers for alternatives.
