


- 2) THE LENGTH WILL VARY DEPENDING ON THE WIDTH OF DRIVEWAY OR SIDEWALK CONSTRUCTION ZONE. IN AREAS WITH MULTIPLE CONSTRUCTION ZONES NEAR EACH OTHER, CONTRACTOR MAY EXTEND THE PATH IN THE CLOSED LANE FOR THE MULTIPLE CONSTRUCTION ZONES BEFORE PEDESTRIANS RAMP UP TO THE EXISTING SIDEWALK.
- 3) DETECTABLE CHANNELIZED PEDESTRIAN BARRICADES SHALL BE PER IDOT STANDARD 701801-05 & 701901-02,
- 4) BARRICADES AND TEMPORARY RAMPS SHALL BE IN PLACE PRIOR TO CONSTRUCTION TO SIDEWALKS OR DRIVEWAYS.
- 5) TEMPORARY RAMPS SHALL BE A SMOOTH, NON-SLIP SURFACE WITH GAPS NO WIDER THAT 1/2."
