GENERAL NOTES

- 1. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL COORDINATE CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES WITH THE RESPECTIVE UTILITY COMPANIES AND THE CITY OF CHICAGO. BEFORE STARTING ANY EXCAVATION, THE CONTRACTOR SHALL CALL THE CHICAGO UTILITY ALERT NETWORK AT (312) 744-7000 FOR FIELD LOCATIONS OF BURIED ELECTRICAL, TELEPHONE, CABLE, AND GAS FACILITIES (48 HOURS NOTIFICATION IS REQUIRED). CONTACT THE CHICAGO DEPARMENT OF WATER MANAGEMENT PERMIT SECTION AT (312) 747-7893 FOR WATER AND SEWER LOCATIONS.
- 2. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL NOT SET UP A YARD OR FIELD OFFICE ON I.D.O.T. PROPERTY WITHOUT WRITTEN PERMISSION FROM I.D.O.T.
- 3. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL TAKE ALL NECESSARY SAFETY PRECAUTIONS TO PROTECT AND PROVIDE ACCESS TO ABUTTING PROPERTY. UTILITIES, PEDESTRIANS, AND VEHICULAR TRAFFIC.
- 4. BARRICADES: THE CONTRACTOR SHALL PROVIDE AND INSTALL TWO WEIGHTED SAND BAGS ON EACH TYPE I OR TYPE II BARRICADE USED (ONE WEIGHTED BAG ACROSS EACH BOTTOM RAIL). ALL TYPE III BARRICADES SHALL REQUIRE A MINIMUM OF FOUR SAND BAGS PER BARRICADE.
- 5. WHEN ARTIFICIAL LIGHTING IS UTILIZED IN NIGHT OPERATIONS, THE CONTRACTOR SHALL EXERCISE THE UTMOST PRECAUTION IN PREVENTING ADVERSE VISIBILITY TO THE MOTORING PUBLIC AND THE ADJOINING COMMERCIAL AND RESIDENTIAL AREAS.
- 6. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL USE CARE IN GRADING OR EXCAVATING NEAR ANY AND ALL EXISTING ITEMS THAT WILL NOT BE REMOVED. ANY DAMAGE DONE TO EXISTING ITEMS BY THE CONTRACTOR SHALL BE REPAIRED BY THE CONTRACTOR AT THE CONTRACTOR'S OWN EXPENSE.
- 7. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL MAINTAIN THE SURFACE DRAINAGE OF ALL ROADWAYS & BRIDGES DURING CONSTRUCTION OF THIS PROJECT. WHEN EXISTING DRAINAGE FACILITIES ARE DISTURBED, THE CONTRACTOR SHALL PROVIDE AND MAINTAIN TEMPORARY OUTLETS AND CONNECTORS FOR ALL PRIVATE OR PUBLIC DRAINS, SEWERS, INLETS AND CATCH BASINS. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL PROVIDE FACILITIES TO TAKE IN ALL STORM WATER WHICH WILL BE RECEIVED BY THESE DRAINS AND SEWERS AND DISCHARGE THE SAME, THE CONTRACTOR SHALL PROVIDE AND MAINTAIN A TEMPORARY OUTLET, AND BE PREPARED AT ALL TIMES TO DISPOSE OF THE WATER RECEIVED FROM THESE TEMPORARY CONNECTIONS UNTIL INSTALLATIONS ARE COMPLETE INCLUDING PAVEMENT. THIS WORK SHALL NOT BE PAID FOR DIRECTLY BUT SHALL BE CONSIDERED INCLUDED IN THE CONTRACT.
- 8. THE UNIT WEIGHT USED FOR ALL BITUMINOUS SURFACE MIXTURES IS 112 LB/SQ YD/IN.
- 9. CRUSHING PLANT AND CONCRETE PLANT LOCATIONS REQUIRE CITY OF CHICAGO APPROVAL.
- 10. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL REMOVE AND DISPOSE OF ANY SEDIMENT ACCUMULATION IN THE VICINITY OF THE CATCH BASINS THAT REQUIRE CLEANING AS DIRECTED BY THE ENGINEER. LIDS SHALL BE RESET AS REQUIRED. COST SHALL BE INCLUDED WITH "CATCH BASINS TO BE CLEANED".
- 11. ALL ELEVATION IN THIS PLAN SET ARE IN THE CITY OF CHICAGO DATUM (CCD). THE FOLLOWING CONVERSION FACTOR IS USED FOR CONVERTING CCD TO NAVD 88: NAVD 88 ELEVATION = CCD+579.19
- 12. THE REMOVAL OF THE EXISTING PAVEMENT MARKING ON THE WB 1-94/90 AND ALL NEW SURFACE REQUIRES THE USE OF EQUIPMENT THAT DO NOT DAMAGE THE SURFACE OR TEXTURE OF THE PAVEMENT. <u>Use hydro-blasting to remove any existing or temporary pavement markings on exist</u>ing or new pavement. ANY DAMAGE DONE TO NEW PAVEMENT BY THE CONTRACTOR SHALL BE REPAIRED BY THE CONTRACTOR AT THE CONTRACTOR'S OWN EXPENSE.
- 13. CONTRACTOR SHOULD COMPLY TO ANY CITY OF CHICAGO NOISE ORDINANCE.
