Dear Mr. Koelm:

This is in regard to your request for authorization to remove an existing single span structure located on Jasper Road over Little Muddy Creek in Clay County, Illinois (N 38.76447, W -88.37587) and replace with a single span bridge with the same alignment. The bridge replacement would require the impacts to 97 linear feet of stream (0.098 acre) and 0.096 acre of wetland, requiring the discharge of 276 cubic yards of fill material. The information supplied by you was reviewed to determine whether a Department of the Army (DA) permit will be required under the provisions of Section 404 of the Clean Water Act.

A review of the proposal indicates the work would be authorized under the provisions of 33 CFR 330 A. Nationwide Permit (NWP) No. 14. <u>Linear Transportation Projects</u>, as published in the Federal Register January 6, 2017. Under the provisions of this authorization you must comply with the enclosed Terms and General Conditions for Nationwide Permit No. 14.

You must also comply with the enclosed Water Quality Certification (WQC) Conditions for Nationwide Permit No. 14, dated March 19, 2017, issued by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (ILEPA). Once you obtain your certification, or if no application was required, you may proceed with the project without further contact or verification from us.

This verification is valid until March 18, 2022. The enclosed Compliance Certification must be submitted to the District Engineer within 30 days of completion of the authorized activity or the implementation of any required compensatory mitigation, whichever occurs later. Note that we also perform periodic inspections to ensure compliance with our permit conditions and applicable Federal laws. A copy of this letter is being sent to your agent and to the ILEPA.
