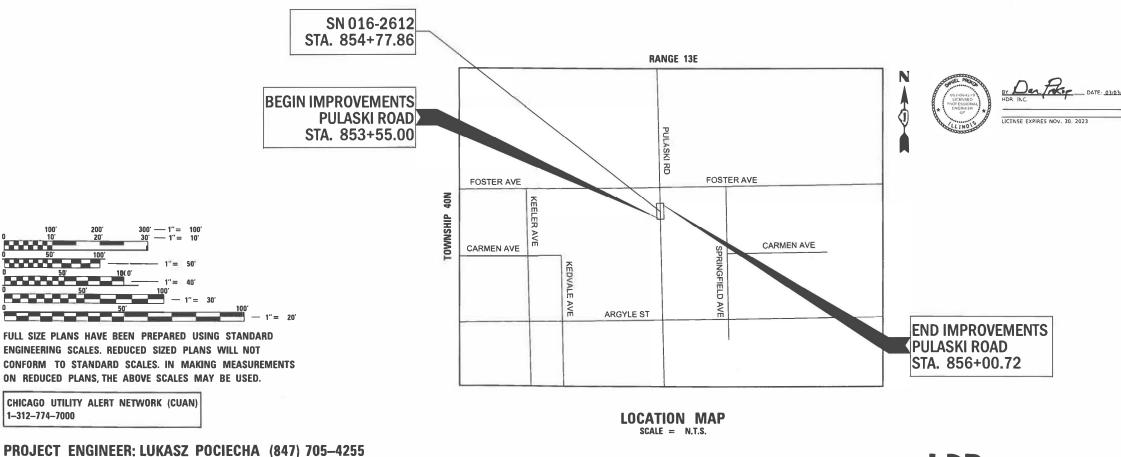

- 3. IT SHALL BE THE CONTRACTOR'S RESPONSIBILITY TO VERIFY ALL DIMENSIONS AND CONDITIONS EXISTING IN THE FIELD PRIOR TO CONSTRUCTION AND ORDERING OF MATERIALS.
- 4. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL CONTACT KALPANA KANNAN-HOSADURGA, THE DISTRICT ONE TRAFFIC CONTROL SUPERVISOR, AT KALPANA.KANNAN-HOSADURGA@ILLINOIS.GOV, A MINIMUM OF 72 HOURS PRIOR TO THE PLACEMENT OF ANY TEMPORARY TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES.
- 5. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL CONTACT EMAD ALHUSSEINI, AREA TRAFFIC FIELD ENGINEER, AT EMAD.ALHUSSEINI@ILLINOIS.GOV AT LEAST TWO (2) WEEKS PRIOR TO THE PLACEMENT OF PERMANENT PAVEMENT MARKINGS.
- 5. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL USE CARE IN GRADING OR EXCAVATING NEAR ANY AND ALL EXISTING ITEMS THAT WILL NOT BE REMOVED. ANY DAMAGE DONE TO EXISTING ITEMS BY THE CONTRACTOR SHALL BE REPAIRED OR REPLACED TO THE SATISFACTION OF THE ENGINEER AT THE CONTRACTOR'S OWN EXPENSE.
- 7. ANY SIGNAGE, PAVEMENT MARKINGS, AND REFLECTORS DAMAGED DURING CONSTRUCTION SHALL BE REPLACED AT THE CONTRACTOR'S EXPENSE.
- 8. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL MAINTAIN POSITIVE DRAINAGE THROUGHOUT THE DURATION OF THE CONTRACT AND MAINTAIN ALL PUBLIC AND PRIVATE DRAINS. TEMPORARY DRAINAGE STRUCTURES MAY BE REQUIRED AND SHALL BE CONSTRUCTED AT THE DIRECTION OF THE ENGINEER. THIS WORK SHALL NOT BE PAID FOR SEPARATELY, BUT WILL BE CONSIDERED INCLUDED IN THE CONTRACT.
- 9. DO NOT SCALE PLANS FOR CONSTRUCTION DIMENSIONS.
- 10. WHEN ARTIFICIAL LIGHTING IS USED IN NIGHT OPERATIONS, THE CONTRACTOR SHALL EXERCISE THE UTMOST PRECAUTIONS IN PREVENTING ADVERSE VISIBILITY TO THE MOTORING PUBLIC.
- 11. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL OBTAIN ALL NECESSARY PERMITS, AS REQUIRED, PRIOR TO COMMENCING WITH CONSTRUCTION.

EXACT LOCATIONS OF ALL PAVEMENT MARKINGS SHALL BE AS DIRECTED BY THE ENGINEER.
- 14. BEFORE STARTING ANY EXCAVATION, THE CONTRACTOR SHALL CALL "C.U.A.N." (CHICAGO UTILITY ALERT NETWORK) AT (312)744-7000 FOR FIELD LOCATIONS OF BURIED ELECTRIC, TELEPHONE AND GAS UTILITIES. (48 HOUR NOTIFICATION IS REQUIRED).
- 15. THE CITY OF CHICAGO IS TO MAKE ADJUSTMENTS TO THEIR STREET LIGHTING AND/OR TRAFFIC SIGNAL FACILITIES. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL COORDINATE HIS WORK AND COOPERATE WITH THE CITY OF CHICAGO IN THESE ADJUSTMENTS. THIS COORDINATION AND COOPERATION BY THE CONTRACTOR WILL NOT BE PAID FOR SEPARATELY BUT SHALL BE CONSIDERED INCLUDED IN THE COSTS OF THE CONTRACT.
- 16. PERMITS FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF SEWERS ARE REQUIRED FOR ALL UNDERGROUND STORM, SANITARY OR COMBINED SEWER SYSTEM CONSTRUCTION, AND FOR RESURFACING WORK INVOLVING ADJUSTMENT OF SEWER STRUCTURES. THE DEPARTMENT OF SEWERS' PERMIT MUST BE OBTAINED BY A LICENSED SEWER DRAIN LAYER PRIOR TO START OF CONSTRUCTION.

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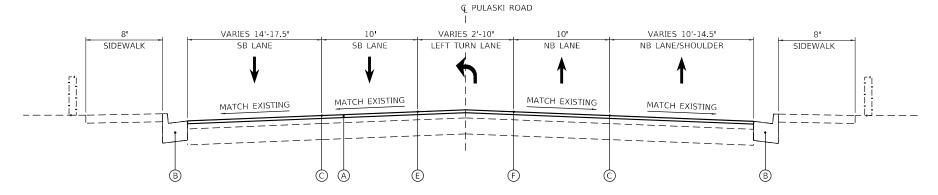

Such variation shall not be cause for additional compensation for a change in scope of the work, however, the Contractor will be paid for the quantity actually furnished at the unit price bid for the work.
- 6. Existing reinforcement extending into the removal area shall be cleaned, straightened, and incorporated into the new construction. Any existing reinforcement bars intended for reuse and damaged during the concrete removal operations shall be repaired or replaced using an approved bar splicer or anchorage system to the satisfaction of the Engineer. Cost included with Concrete Removal.
- 7. The Contractor shall take appropriate measures to assure the Protective Coat is not applied to the drainage scuppers.
- 8. Joint openings shall be adjusted according to Article 520.04 of the Standard Specifications when the deck is poured at an ambient temperature other than 50°F.
- 9. Cleaning and field painting of structural steel shall be done under a separate painting contract.
- 10. Existing structural steel that will be in contact with new structural steel shall be cleaned and painted as required by the Special Provision "Cleaning and Painting Contact Surface Areas of Existing Steel Structures."
- 11. All structural steel shall be shop painted with the inorganic zinc rich primer per AASHTO M300, Type 1. Cost included with Furnishing and Erecting Structural Steel.
- 12. Hollow structural steel tubing shall conform to the requirements of ASTM Designation A500, Grade B, Structural Steel Tubing.
- 13. All other structural steel shapes and plates provided for the Bridge Rail shall conform to the requirements of AASHTO M 270 Grade 36.
- 14. Refer to the specification Debris Removal (Special) for the coordination and notification procedures required for the relocation of homeless individuals prior to cleanup. The assumed Contract quantity for Debris Removal (Special) is based on the volume of removed trash and debris equal to fill one 20 Cubic Yard dumpster.

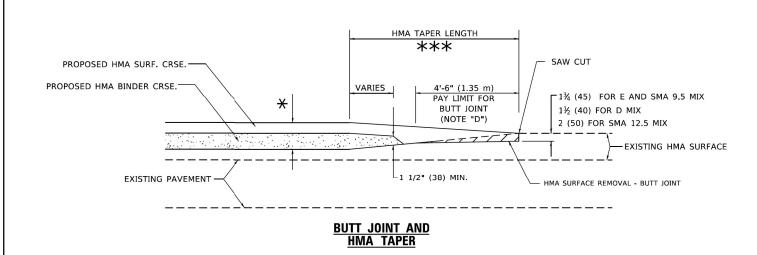


HMA CONSTRUCTED TEMPORARY RAMP

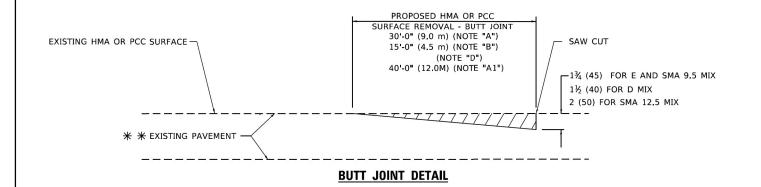

- 1. HALF OF THE SIGNS WILL REQUIRE A LEFT HAND FACING ARROW.
- 2. TWO SIGNS SHALL BE USED AT EACH COMMERCIAL ENTRANCE PLACED BACK-TO-BACK: ONE WITH A RIGHT HAND ARROW (SHOWN) SHALL BE PLACED ON THE NEAR RIGHT SIDE THE DRIVEWAY AND ONE WITH A LEFT HAND ARROW SHALL BE PLACED ON THE FAR LEFT SIDE OF THE DRIVEWAY.
- 3. SIGNS TO BE PAID FOR AS ITEM "TEMPORARY INFORMATION SIGNING".
