The use of Project Labor Agreement (PLA) for Contract 62H16 is consistent with all State and Local statutory and regulatory requirements.

Item 3: This project includes both State and Federal funding and the programmed cost for this project is estimated at \$5,000,000.

The existing bridge center median will be removed to provide room for side-by-side left turn lanes which will include removal of concrete median, traffic signal modifications, bridge deck repairs and ¾" deck scarification and 2 ¼" Latex Concrete overly with slight roadway profile improvement. Additional bridge structure maintenance is needed as well and includes expansion joint replacement and structural repairs. Additionally, the ramps will be widened to provide an additional turn lane to increase safety. Traffic signal modernization and lighting upgrades will be installed at both ramps as part of this project. The NE/SE Frontage Road will also be widened to increase safety and will also include traffic signal improvements. Profile changes will be minimal. The intersection of US 52 and the NE/SE Frontage Road is PCC, while the roadway extension itself is HMA. Concrete shoulder is proposed as part of the widening improvement. Drainage improvements are planned to accommodate the widened roadway and maintain existing.

The project is located in the Village of Shorewood, Will County, Illinois.
