





GENERAL NOTES

- 1. PROJECT DESCRIPTION: THIS PROJECT SHALL CONSIST OF REMARKING THE EXISTING RUNWAY 9/27 AND THE ASSOCIATED AIRFIELD PAVEMENTS INCLUDING TAXIWAYS AND THE GENERAL AVIATION RAMP AT THE MACOMB MUNICIPAL AIRPORT.
- 2. THE PROJECT PAY ITEMS ARE INTENDED TO BE INCLUSIVE OF ALL WORK TO BE PERFORMED AS SHOWN IN THESE PLANS. ALL INCIDENTAL WORK REQUIRED TO COMPLETE THE PROJECT TO THE SATISFACTION OF THE RESIDENT ENGINEER/RESIDENT TECHNICIAN IS TO BE INCLUDED IN THE COSTS OF PERFORMING THESE ITEMS. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL FURNISH ALL LABOR, MATERIAL, EQUIPMENT, AND TRANSPORTATION NECESSARY TO CONSTRUCT ALL ELEMENTS OF THE PROJECT AS DESCRIBED IN THE CONSTRUCTION PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS.
- 3. THE RULES, REGULATIONS, AND SPECIFICATIONS ENUMERATED HEREIN SHALL BE CONSIDERED AS MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS. THEY SHALL NOT PROHIBIT THE CONTRACTOR FROM FURNISHING AND INSTALLING HIGHER GRADES OF MATERIAL THAN ARE SPECIFIED HEREIN, IF APPROVED BY THE ENGINEER.
- 4. ACCESS TO THE SITE SHALL BE RESTRICTED EXCLUSIVELY TO THE DESIGNATED CONSTRUCTION ENTRANCE, STAGING AREA, AND HAUL ROUTE. NO EQUIPMENT OR PERSONNEL SHALL BE PERMITTED OUTSIDE THE GENERAL PROJECT AREA.
- 5. IT SHALL BE THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE CONTRACTOR TO PROTECT AND KEEP CLEAN OF DEBRIS ALL EXISTING AIRFIELD AND ROADWAY PAVEMENTS AT ALL TIMES. ANY DAMAGE TO EXISTING UTILITY, DRAINAGE, AND PAVEMENT STRUCTURES SHALL BE IMMEDIATELY REPAIRED AT NO ADDITIONAL COST TO THE CONTRACT.
- 6. THE CONTRACTOR IS REQUIRED TO PROVIDE THEIR OWN RESTROOM FACILITIES.
- 7. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR OBTAINING PERMITS FOR HAULING ON PUBLIC ROADS, AS APPLICABLE. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR CORRECTING ANY DAMAGES TO ANY PAVEMENTS (PUBLIC OR PRIVATE) CAUSED BY HIS/HER EQUIPMENT OR PERSONNEL.

- 10. <u>CERTIFIED PAYROLLS</u> THE RESIDENT ENGINEER/RESIDENT TECHNICIAN <u>CANNOT</u> FORWARD A CONSTRUCTION REPORT FOR PAYMENT TO THE IDOT-DIVISION OF AERONAUTICS FOR PROCESSING UNTIL <u>ALL</u> CERTIFIED PAYROLLS FOR THAT PERIOD HAVE BEEN RECEIVED.






DETAIL OF CROSS FOR CLOSED RUNWAY

CONSTRUCTION SAFETY PLAN

GENERAL - THE MACOMB MUNICIPAL AIRPORT IS COMPRISED OF PAVED RUNWAY 9/27, AND TURF RUNWAY 18/36. THE PROPOSED CONSTRUCTION WILL REQUIRE DAYTIME CLOSURES OF RUNWAY 9/27 AND ITS ASSOCIATED TAXIWAYS WHEN WORKING WITHIN "WORK AREA 1" AS DELINEATED ON THE PLAN SHEET. RUNWAY 18/36 AND THE GA RAMP WILL ALSO REQUIRE CLOSURE WHILE MARKING IS BEING COMPLETED IN "WORK AREA 2" AS SHOWN. NO OVERNIGHT OR WEEKEND CLOSURES WILL BE PERMITTED.

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2. AIR OPERATIONS AREA (AOA)

- THE AIR OPERATIONS AREA (AOA) FOR RUNWAY 9/27 IS GOVERNED BY THE OBSTACLE FREE ZONE (OFZ) TO A WIDTH OF 125' FROM THE RUNWAY CENTERLINE. AT NO TIME MAY THE CONTRACTOR WORK IN THIS AREA WHILE RUNWAY 9/27 IS OPEN TO AIR TRAFFIC.
- THE AOA FOR RUNWAY 18/36 IS GOVERNED BY THE OBSTACLE FREE ZONE (OFZ) TO A WIDTH OF 125' FROM THE RUNWAY CENTERLINE. AT NO TIME MAY THE CONTRACTOR WORK IN THIS AREA WHILE RUNWAY 18/36 IS OPEN TO AIR TRAFFIC.
- THE CONTRACTOR MAY UTILIZE ADDITIONAL CONES AND BARRICADES AS DIRECTED BY THE RESIDENT FNGINFER/TECHNICIAN TO CLOSE ISOLATED TAXIWAY AREAS WHEN WORKING OUTSIDE THE RUNWAY
- 4. ALL WORK SHALL BE DONE IN AN ORDERLY AND EFFECTIVE MANNER TO MINIMIZE AIRFIELD AND IMPACTS
- ALL RUNWAY/TAXIWAY CLOSURES SHALL BE COORDINATED WITH THE AIRPORT MANAGER A MINIMUM OF 72 HOURS BEFORE THE DESIRED CLOSING TIME. THE AIRPORT MANAGER HAS COMPLETE AUTHORITY IN DETERMINING WHEN THE RUNWAY/TAXIWAY MAY BE CLOSED.

RUNWAY/TAXIWAY CLOSURE PROCEDURES

- CONTACT THE AIRPORT MANAGEMENT OR ASSIGNED REPRESENTATIVE A MINIMUM OF 72 HOURS BEFORE THE DESIRED CLOSING TIME.
- ISSUANCE OF NOTAM AND DEACTIVATION OF THE APPLICABLE AIRFIELD LIGHTING AND NAVAIDS BY THE AIRPORT MANAGEMENT AND/OR FAA.
- PLACEMENT OF CROSSES AND LIGHTED BARRICADES.

ONLY AT THE TIME THAT ALL OF THE ABOVE ARE COMPLETED MAY ANY CONSTRUCTION OPERATIONS BEGIN WITHIN THE RUNWAY/TAXIWAY AIR OPERATIONS AREA.



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


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

RUNWAY MARKING PLAN - STA, 100+00 TO STA. 126+00





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


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

RUNWAY MARKING PLAN - STA. 126+00 TO STA. 151+00





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


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
