TRAFFIC CONTROL PLAN

Effective 1985 Revised 12/11/19

During the entire construction period, the road shall be kept open to traffic as follows:

- (a) I-57 will be allowed to be reduced to one lane in each direction only during off peak hours. Off peak hours are defined as: Northbound 8:00 pm to 8:00 am and Southbound 8:00 pm to 8:00 am. Failure to have two lanes in each direction open during peak hours will result in a penalty as defined in Art. 105.03(b). Delivery or removal of large quantities of material will not be allowed during peak hours. Large quantities shall be defined as more than one truck per hour.
- (b) Traffic must be reduced to one lane when workers are present while work is being performed in the middle lane.
- (c) Traffic control setup, switching of stages, and removal shall only be done at off peak hours.
