CONSTRUCTION PROCEDURES

STAGE 1 (BEFORE PAVEMENT MILLING)

- A) REMOVE A MINIMUM OF 12 (300) OF THE PAVEMENT FROM AROUND THE STRUCTURE.
- B) REMOVE THE EXISTING FRAME AND LID FROM THE STRUCTURE.
- C) COVER THE STRUCTURE OPENING WITH A 36 (900) DIAMETER METAL PLATE.
- D) BACKFILL WITH CRUSHED STONE AND A MINIMUM $1\frac{1}{2}$ (40) THICK HMA SURFACE MIX APPROVED BY THE ENGINEER.

STAGE 2 (AFTER PAVEMENT MILLING)

- A) REMOVE THE HMA SURFACE MIX AND CRUSHED STONE.
- B) INSTALL THE FRAME AND LID; ADJUST THE FRAME TO ITS FINAL SURFACE ELEVATION.
- C) THE SURROUNDING SPACE SHALL BE FILLED WITH CLASS SI CONCRETE, OR HMA SURFACE COURSE OR HMA BINDER COURSE TO THE ELEVATION OF THE SURFACE OF THE EXISTING BASE COURSE OR THE BINDER COURSE.





- C: WITHIN 10 FT (3m) OF THE EDGE OF CURB, SHOULDER, OR PAVEMENT.
- D: PARALLEL TO THE CROSSWALK TO BE USED (SEE MUTCD FIGURE 4E-2).
- E: NORMAL PEDESTRIAN PUSHBUTTON MOUNTING HEIGHT SHOULD BE 3.5 FT (1.05m) ABOVE ADJACENT SIDEWALK






