Item 8. Any disruption in the continuity of this project due to labor issues would result in delayed completion of the project that would cause safety concerns for the traveling public

This project scope is for completion of resurfacing, striping and guardrail work for a two-lane state highway that is a major travel route for the commuting public from Brimfield to Peoria. This project also includes the closure of this road for a culvert removal and replacement. Any work stoppage that would extend the completion of the project after construction has begun would be detrimental to the motoring public because of possible lane reductions, barricades, cones, insufficient pavement markings, incomplete or missing guardrail, and/or stored equipment along the roadside that would remain idle for the duration of the labor dispute. That would represent a risk to public safety for commuters along the route. If a labor dispute were to occur during the road closure period, the road would be completely impassable at the culvert location, adding travel time and mileage for commuters using the marked detour for longer than anticipated periods of time.
