All wood rails shall comply with Article 1007.03. All rails shall be rough cut. Dimensions of rails are net, not nominal dimensions. All rails shall be treated in accordance with Article 1007.12. All rail posts, splice plates and base plates shall be painted as noted in the Special Provisions. All other steel shapes and plates shall conform to the requirements of AASHTO M-270, Grade 36 except posts shall conform to AASHTO M-270, Grade 50. Bolts, cap screws and nuts shall conform to the requirements of ASTM designation A-307 except that threaded rods, nuts and washers shall conform to AASHTO M-164. All bolts, nuts, cap screws, washers and lock washers shall be

shall conform to AASHTO M-164. All bolts, nuts, cap screws, washers and lock washers shall be galvanized in accordance with AASHTO M-232. All posts, rail splices and anchor rods shall be galvanized after shop fabrication in accordance with AASHTO M-111 and ASTM A-385. The contractor shall use the capsule or the adhesive cartridge type anchor rods that have been previously tested and given a prior approval by the department. The contractor shall install these anchor rods in pre-drilled holes in accordance with the manufacturer's recommendations and procedures
