FERTILIZING AND SEEDING

All earth surfaces disturbed by the Contractor shall be seeded in accordance with Section 250 and mulched in accordance with Section 251, Mulch, Method 2, Procedure 1 of the Standard Specifications. All areas shall receive SEEDING, CLASS 2 SPECIAL. Fertilizer nutrients, limestone, and mulch shall be applied as hereinafter specified except that the fertilizer nutrients, limestone, and mulch will not be paid for separately but shall be included in the unit bid price for SEEDING, CLASS 2 SPECIAL.

Spring seeding shall be done between January 1 and June 30. Fall seeding shall be done between July 1 and December 31.

OPEN BURNING

Revised 7-26-07

Open burning will be allowed in accordance with Section 202.03 of the Standard Specifications.

OVERHAUL

No payment for Overhaul will be allowed for earth hauled from any source.

CUTTING EXISTING SIDEWALK, CURB AND GUTTER, OR PAVEMENT

At locations where it is necessary to cut concrete sidewalk, concrete curb and gutter, or P.C.C. or bituminous pavement for removal and replacement, a uniformly straight cut shall be obtained by the use of a pavement saw. The use of pneumatic tools to make these cuts will not be allowed.

Where new PC Concrete Pavement or Combination Concrete Curb and Gutter is to be placed against existing concrete pavement and the existing pavement, curb or combination curb and gutter is to be removed, the existing pavement shall be sawed full depth (including sawing
