Item 3: This project includes both State and Federal funding and the programmed cost for this project is estimated at \$5,500,000. The scope of work consists of superstructure replacement of Parnell Avenue bridge over Interstate 57 (Dan Ryan Expressway). Shallower composite beams are proposed to provide a 15'-3" vertical clearance over I-57 without significantly changing the profile of Parnell Avenue. Additional work includes substructure repair, drainage repairs, ADA and lighting improvements.
