


## TEMPORARY EROSION CONTROL NOTES

4. CLEAN DRAINAGE FACILITIES AND REMOVE TEMPORARY EROSION DEVICES WITHIN 30 DAYS AFTER FINAL SITE STABILIZATION IS ACHIEVED.

- 1. ALL CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES SHALL BE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) STORM WATER POLICY.
- 2. THE CONCTRACTOR SHALL INSTALL PERIMETER EROSION BARRIER PRIOR TO STRIPPING OF VEGETATION.
- 3. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL SURROUND ANY NECESSARY EARTH STOCKPILES WITH PERIMETER EROSION BARRIER.
- 4. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL MAINTAIN ALL EROSION CONTROL DEVICES AT ALL TIMES. EROSION CONTROL DEVICES SHALL BE INSPECTED EVERY SEVEN CALENDAR DAYS OR WITHIN 24 HOURS AFTER A 13 MM (0.5 INCH) RAINFALL OR SNOWFALL.
- 5. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL SEED ALL DISTURBED AREAS AS SOON AS PRACTICAL AFTER CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES IN THAT AREA HAVE BEEN CONCLUDED. AREAS THAT HAVE STEEP SLOPES OR WILL NOT RECIEVE PERMANENT LANDSCAPING SHALL BE TEMPORARILY SEEDED. ALL FLATTER AREAS OR AREAS WHERE NO FURTHER WORK IS TO OCCUR FOR ONE MONTH OR MORE SHALL BE SEEDED AND EXCELSIOR BLANKET WITHIN SEVEN (7) CALENDAR DAYS.
- 6. THE PERMIT ISSUED TO THE ILLINOIS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION DOES NOT COVER IN-STREAM WORK BY THE CONTRACTOR. AFTER AWARD, THE CONTRACTOR WILL NEED TO COORDINATE AND HAVE A WORK PLAN APPROVED BY THE US ARMY CORPS OF ENGINEERS (USACOE).
