The Traffic Signal Cabinet and controller shall be according to NEMA Standards for Traffic control Systems.

All traffic signal sections shall be 12" heads.

Heads shall be placed as indicated on the Temporary Traffic Signal plan or as directed by the Engineer.

The Contractor shall furnish enough cable slack to relocate heads to any position on the span wire or at locations illustrated on the plans for construction staging. The Temporary Traffic Signals shall remain in operation during all signal head relocations. Each Temporary Traffic Signal head shall have its own cable from the controller cabinet to the signal head.

The Contractor shall provide all labor, equipment and materials required to relocate the Temporary Traffic Signal Heads in accordance with the proposed staging.

All labor, materials and equipment required to comply with these requirements shall be included in the price for TEMPORARY TRAFFIC SIGNAL INSTALLATION.
