In accordance with the Project Labor Agreement Act (30 ILCS 571), it is recommended that a project labor agreement (PLA) be utilized for the above-captioned Project. This recommendation is based on the considerations indicated below.		
⊠ 1) The Project is being awarded and administered by IDOT (i.e., not by another governmental agency).		
2) The Project is being constructed using state or local funds only (i.e., no federal funds).		
⊠ 3) The overall size, scope, sequencing, logistics or other aspects of the Project make it particularly challenging to manage, and use of a PLA is expected to help assure that the construction work is performed properly and efficiently under the circumstances. (See Attachment A)		
4) The duration of construction activity on the Project is expected to exceed one construction season (i.e., 110 or more working days), or the nature of the Project results in a heightened need for labor force continuity and stability over a substantial period of time.		
⊠ 5) There is a firm construction completion date established for the Project thereby increasing the adverse consequences of any work stoppage or other labor disruption. (See Attachment A)		
⊠ 6) The time required to complete the Project is expected to extend beyond the expiration date of one or more existing collective bargaining agreements covering trades likely to be involved in the Project, thereby increasing the likelihood of work stoppage(s) or other labor disruption(s) during construction of the Project. (See List of Unions)		
7) In the absence of a PLA, there is an increased likelihood of jurisdictional disputes among unions or of conflict between unionized and non-unionized workers on the Project that could have a potentially material adverse effect on the time, cost, or quality of work performed on the Project.

Justification for use of a Project Labor Agreement on FAI 70/ FAI 270 (I-70/ I-270) and FAI 55/70 (I-5570), Contract Number 76H84, Madison County which involves resurfacing and minor bridge repairs along I-70/270 and an Ultra-Thin Bonded Wearing Course along I-55/70.

ITEM 3: Estimated project cost is \$21,000,000.00. The project is approximately 6.34 miles.

The work on this project consists of patching and resurfacing of mainline lanes, ramps, and shoulders, approximately 1 mile of pavement widening, structure repairs, guardrail replacement, pipe underdrain replacement and other drainage repairs, sign truss repairs, pavement marking, raised reflective pavement markers along I-70/270 and an Ultra-Thin Bonded Wearing Course, HMA surface removal, pavement marking, raised reflective pavement markers along I-55/70 plus other work necessary to complete the project.
