- 2. WHERE SECTION OR SUBSECTION MONUMENTS ARE ENCOUNTERED, THE ENGINEER SHALL BE NOTIFIED BEFORE SUCH MONUMENTS ARE REMOVED. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL PROTECT AND CAREFULLY PRESERVE ALL MONUMENTS UNTIL AN AUTHORIZED SURVEYOR OR AGENT HAS WITNESSED OR OTHERWISE REFERENCED THEIR LOCATION. THE CONTRACTOR WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR HAVING AN AUTHORIZED SURVEYOR RE-ESTABLISH ANY SECTION OR SUBSECTION MONUMENTS DESTROYED BY HIS OPERATIONS.
- ANY REFERENCE TO A STANDARD IN THESE PLANS SHALL BE INTERPRETED TO MEAN THE EDITION AS INDICATED BY THE SUB-NUMBER LISTED OR THE COPY OF THE STANDARD INCLUDED IN THESE PLANS.
- 4. ABANDONED UNDERGROUND UTILITIES THAT CONFLICT WITH CONSTRUCTION SHALL BE DISPOSED OUTSIDE THE LIMITS OF RIGHT OF WAY ACCORDING TO ARTICLE 202.03 OF THE STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS AND AS DIRECTED BY THE ENGINEER. THIS WORK WILL NOT BE PAID FOR SEPARATELY BUT SHALL BE INCLUDED IN THE COST OF EARTH EXCAVATION AND NO ADDITIONAL COMPENSATION WILL BE ALLOWED.
- 5. ALL DISTURBED UNSURFACED AREAS WITHIN THE ROW AND EASEMENTS SHALL BE SEEDED, FERTILIZED, AND MULCHED AS SHOWN IN THE PLANS, SPECIAL PROVISIONS, AND AS DIRECTED BY THE ENGINEER. SEEDING WILL NOT BE PERMITTED AT ANY TIME WHEN THE GROUND IS FROZEN, WET OR IN AN UNTILLABLE CONDITION.
- FERTILIZER NUTRIENTS SHALL BE APPLIED TO BOTH THE SEEDED AREAS AND THE AREAS COVERED WITH EROSION CONTROL BLANKET.
