Justification for use of a Project Labor Agreement on FAP 10/789 (US 67/IL-111) Contract Number 76L29, Madison County which involves resurfacing of the US 67/IL 111 and ADA improvements from 0.1 mile north of Airport Road to IL 3 in Godfrey and all other roadway items associated to maintain two lanes of traffic during construction.

Federal Project Number: NHPP-TJUS(134)

ITEM 3: Estimated project cost is \$5,000,000.

The proposed project consists of the milling and resurfacing US 67/IL 111 and providing ADA improvement from 0.1 mile north of Airport Rd to IL 3 in Godfrey. This project consists of milling 2-3/4" and resurfacing the roadway pavement 2-3/4", and all incidental and collateral work necessary to complete the project as shown on the plans and as described herein.

ITEM 5: Construction is anticipated from Winter 2022 thru Fall 2023. This roadway carries 11,600-21,000 vehicles per day and is the main roadway into Lewis & Clark Community College. One lane of traffic will be open at all times in each direction and peak hour restrictions will be utilized. This will cause construction to take longer than if work were allowed all hours. As construction is drawn out, this will continue to be an impact to drivers.
