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
## FORM LINER TEXTURED SURFACE

### **Description:**

This work shall consist of installing a form liner textured surface to the cast-in-place concrete wall in accordance with Section 503 of the Standard Specifications, the plans, the provisions herein and as directed by the Engineer.

#### Surface Pattern:

The aesthetics of exposed surface panels for the retaining wall shall be as follows:



The pattern of the form liner shall appear natural and non-repeating. Seam lines or match lines caused from two or more molds coming together will not be apparent when viewing final wall. The molds shall be removable without causing deterioration of surface or underlying concrete.

The forms shall be properly braced or tied together to maintain position and shape. The forms shall be made sufficiently tight to prevent leakage of the mortar. The formwork shall have the strength and stability to ensure finished concrete dimensions within the tolerances specified herein.

The wall shall be constructed with a coursed stone rusticated surface with a 1" relief. The finish shall consist of a Random Ashlar Stone finish and shall have a minimum 0.75 in impression.

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The Engineer has pre-approved the following form liner suppliers and patterns for the textured surface:

- 1. Sika Corporation, IL Pattern #477 Meramec Drystack Stone. usa.sika.com
- 2. Scott System, CO Pattern #189, Teton Drystack. www.scottsystem.com
- 3. Custom Rock, MN Pattern #1208, Drystack. www.customrock.com

Any other similar form liner and its specifications must be submitted to the Resident Engineer for approval.

Any touch up and repair is at the Contractor's expense and shall be carried out according to the manufacturer's recommendations or as directed by the Engineer.

The Contractor shall submit a 2 ft x 2 ft sample of the textures and patterns proposed for use on the project for approval.

### **Basis of Payment:**

This work shall be paid for at the contract unit price per SQUARE FOOT for FORM LINER TEXTURED SURFACE.
