## AGREEMENT

THE COUNTY OF COOR . STATE OF ILLINOIS EUCLID-WEST LAKE AVENUE. WOLF ROAD TO LANDWENR ROM SECTION 111-0608 CF. STATE SECTION 1973-38-8

THIS AGREEMENT made and entered into by and between the COUNTY OF COOK, a body politic and corporate of the STATE OF ILLINOIS, hereinafter called "COUNTY" and the STATE OF ILLINOIS, acting by and through its Department of Transportation, hereinafter called ; "STATE".

## WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, the COUNTY; in order to facilitate the free flow of traffic and insure safety to the motoring public; desires: to improve approximately 15, 425 lineal feet of Euclid-West Lake Avenue, State Route CHS III, State Section1973-38-R, County Section 111-0608 CP, from Wolf Road to a point east of Landwehr Road by reconstructing the existing road from the propent typical width of 22 foat, to a nominal width of 52 feat, and variable edge to edge of pavement (providing for four twelve-foot traffic lanes a nominal four-foot wide median variable to 16 feet at channelized intersections), curb and gutter, constructing storm severs and appurtenances for highway drainage, channelizing the Euclid-West Lake intersections with Wolf Road, DesPlaines River Road and Milwaukee Avonue and with Landwehr Road (to the morth), and modernizing and relocating the traffic control: signals at the intersections with Wolf Road, DesPlaines River Road and Hilwankee. Avenue, providing traffic signals at Landwehr: Road, reconstructing the existing at-grade (Soo Line Railroad) crossing and modernizing the present flashing light-gate protection with flashing light signals and gates and median flashing light units? videning 30 for (approximately) of bridge roadway ... over a slough at Station. 61+41 and widoning 162 feet (approximately), of bridge roadway over DeaPlaines River: and performing all other work necessary to and complote the improvement in accordance with approved, plans and apocifications; and

INHEREAS, the COUNTY and STATE desire the improvement in that it will be of immediate bonefit to the residents of Cook County in its vicinity and permanent in nature; and

NHEREAS, the COUNTY has propared plans and specifications for the improvement, and is concluding a grade crossing agreement with the Soo Line Railroad to improve the crossing to a degree consistent with the highway improvement; and

WHREAS, the COUNTY is acquiring all necessary right of way in accordance with applicable State of Illinois statutes procedures thorough its State's Attorney, except at the Intersec of Milwaukee Averna where certain right of way is being acquired STATE; and

WHEREAS, no relocation advisory assistance is necessary. NOW, THEREPORE, the COUNTY and STATE agree as follows: 1. The COUNTY will make the surveys, obtain all necessary right of way remaining (except at Milwaukee Avenue), prepare plans and specifications, receive bids and award the contract, furnish angineering inspection during construction and cause the improvement to be built in accordance with the plans, specifications and contract 1 . 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## RESOLUTION Providing for Jurisdictional Transfer of a Highway in Cook County

WHEREAS, the State of Illinois, acting through its Department of Transportation, hereinafter called the STATE and Cook County, hereinafter called the COUNTY, have mutually determined that it is in the interest of each party to transfer jurisdiction of F.A.U. Route No. 1292 (Euclid/Lake Avenue) extending from <u>\$30</u> feet west of Plum Grove Road to Northwest Highway (U.S. Route 14), and from Douglas Avenue to Skokie Boulevard (U.S. Route 14) a distance of approximately 15 miles from the State Highway System to the County Highway System; and

WHEREAS, the authority to enter into this contract is granted the STATE by Section 4-409 of the Illinois Highway Code and the deletion from the State Highway System is granted under Section 2-101 of the Illinois Highway Code; and

WHEREAS, the authority to make changes to the County Highway System is granted the COUNTY by Section 5-105 of the Illinois Highway Code.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that F.A.U. Route No. 1292 (Euclid/ Lake Avenue) extending from 830 feet west of Plum Grove Road to Northwest Highway (U.S. Route 14), and from Douglas Avenue to Skokie Boulevard (U.S. Route 41) be added to the County Highway System of said COUNTY, upon approval of the STATE, and that said route be identified as County Highway No. 113; and BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the clerk is hereby directed to transmit two certified copies of this resolution to the State through its District Engineer's office at Schaumburg, Illinois.
