The use of Project Labor Agreement (PLA) for Contract 62W38 is consistent with all State and Local statutory and regulatory requirements.

Item 3: This project includes both State and Federal funding and the programmed cost for this project is estimated at \$61,000,000. The scope of work for this improvement includes the rehabilitation of four (4) bridges along IL-53 from Kirchoff Road to Anderson Drive. This includes the full superstructure replacement of IL-53 at Kirchoff Road, Palatine Road, and Anderson Drive. In addition, this contract includes structural work for the deck replacement of IL-53 at Industrial Avenue and culvert repairs at IL-53 over Salt Creek. Additional improvements include resurfacing of IL 53 within the contract limits, ramp repairs and resurfacing, retaining wall, construction of sidewalk, aesthetic bridge work on some bridges, signal improvements, lighting, and ITS improvements.
