## LANDSCAPE INSTALLATION GENERAL NOTES:

1. UTILITY COORDINATION:

ILLINOIS STATE LAW REQUIRES A 48-HOUR NOTICE BE GIVEN TO ALL UTILITIES WITHIN THE PROJECT AREA BEFORE DIGGING BY CALLING J.U.L.I.E. AND BY NOTIFYING NON-J.U.L.I.E. MEMBERS INDIVIDUALLY. FIELD MARKING OF FACILITIES MAY ALSO BE OBTAINED BY PROVIDING A MINIMUM OF 96-HOURS NOTICE TO THE RESIDENT ENGINEER SO THAT UTILITY COMPANIES CAN BE NOTIFIED. 

- 2. VERIFICATION OF DIMENSIONS AND GRADES, BOTH EXISTING AND PROPOSED, SHALL BE THE CONTRACTOR'S RESPONSIBILITY PRIOR TO COMMENCEMENT OF WORK, THE CONTRACTOR SHALL NOTIFY THE DISTRICT ROADSIDE MANAGEMENT SPECIALIST, RON CHLOPEK, 618-346-3286 OF ANY DISCREPANCIES.
- 3. ALL SURFACE DRAINAGE SHALL BE DIRECTED AWAY FROM BUILDINGS. SURFACE DRAINAGE SHALL BE DIRECTED TO EXISTING DRAINAGE STRUCTURES DESIGNATED FOR THE COLLECTION OF SURFACE RUN-OFF.
- 4. CONTRACTOR SHALL REPAIR IN KIND ANY AREAS DAMAGED AS A RESULT OF LANDSCAPE OPERATIONS AT NO ADDITIONAL COST TO THE CONTRACT.
- 5. ALL SODDING, SALT TOLERANT AREAS SHALL HAVE FERTILIZER APPLIED AT A 1:1:1 RATIO AS FOLLOWS: NITROGEN FERTILIZER NUTRIENT - 60 LBS/ACRE

PHOSPHORUS FERTILIZER NUTRIENT - 60 LBS/ACRE
POTASSIUM FERTILIZER NUTRIENT - 60 LBS/ACRE

- 6. ALL SEEDING, CLASS 2A AREAS SHALL HAVE FERTILIZER APPLIED AT A 1:1:1 RATIO AS FOLLOWS: NITROGEN FERTILIZER NUTRIENT - 90 LBS/ACRE PHOSPHORUS FERTILIZER NUTRIENT - 90 LBS/ACRE POTASSIUM FERTILIZER NUTRIENT - 90 LBS/ACRE
- 7. ALL SEEDING, CLASS 3A, SEEDING, CLASS 4A, SEEDING CLASS 4B AND SEEDING CLASS 7 (SPECIAL) AREAS SHALL NOT REQUIRE FERTILIZER NUTRIENTS.
- 8. EROSION CONTROL BLANKET SHALL BE APPLIED TO ALL SEEDED AREAS.
- 9. SUPPLEMENTAL WATERING SHALL BE APPLIED AT THE DIRECTION OF THE ENGINEER AT A RATE OF 3 GAL/SQ YD, OR AT THE RATE DIRECTED BY THE ENGINEER.
- 10. THE SEEDING AND SODDING SHOWN IN THESE PLANS SHALL SUPERCEDE THE PERMANENT CONFLICTING SEEDING SHOWN IN CONTRACT 76C55 IN THE VICINITY OF THE DETENTION
- 11. THE RECOMMENDED PLANTING DATES SHALL BE AS FOLLOWS: THE SEEDING, CLASS 7 (SPECIAL) SHALL CONSIST OF 48 LBS PER ACRE OF SPRING OATS FROM MARCH 1 TO JULY 31 AND 56 LBS PER ACRE OF BALBOA FARM RYE OR 60 LBS PER ACRE OF WINTER WHEAT FROM AUG. 1 TO NOV. 15.
- 12. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL COORDINATE THE LANDSCAPING PLANTING SCHEDULE WITH CONTRACT 76C76 TO ENSURE THAT THE EMBANKMENT GRADES ARE FINALIZED AT THE LIMITS OF BOTH CONTRACTS AND THE PROPOSED LANDSCAPING IMPROVEMENTS CAN BE CONSTRUCTED WITHOUT CONFLICT.
- 13. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL COORDINATE THE LANDSCAPING PLANTING SCHEDULE WITH CONTRACT 76C54 TO ENSURE THAT THE PROPOSED LIGHTING AND CONDUITS ARE FINALIZED IN THE AREAS OF THE PROPOSED LANDSCAPING, AND THE LANDSCAPING IMPROVEMENTS CAN BE CONSTRUCTED WITHOUT CONFLICT.
- 14. SELECTIVE MOWING STAKES SHALL BE INSTALLED ALONG THE BORDER BETWEEN THE SEEDING, CLASS 2A AND ALL OTHER TYPES OF SEEDING. THE SELECTIVE MOWING STAKES SHALL BE INSTALLED EVERY 200' FOR LONG & FAIRLY STRAIGHT RUNS, AND EVERY 25' FOR TIGHT CURVES.
