Justification for use of project Labor Agreement on Contract **68F38**, Peoria / Tazewell Counties:

The use of a project Labor Agreement on this project is consistent with all State and Local statutory regulatory requirements.

### **Project Description**

This project is located on IL Route 40 (N William Kumpf Boulevard) including Structure No. 090-0122 over the Illinois River between Adams Street in the city of Peoria, Peoria County and Tractor Drive/River Road in the city of East Peoria, Tazewell County, Illinois. The work consists of a microsilica concrete deck overlay, reconfiguration of the deck to add a concrete barrier separated multi-use path, bridge deck repair, beam repairs, beam additions, navigation and roadway lighting, traffic signal improvements, drainage improvements, full depth pavement removal and replacement, sidewalk/parapet removals, multi-use path construction, and related collateral work necessary to complete the project.

Item 3: The estimated project cost is \$19.0 million. The challenging logistics for this project include extensive traffic control to allow closure of the bridge to vehicular traffic from March 13 through November 17, 2023; staging of pedestrians and cyclists across the bridge throughout construction; intersection improvements on each end of the structure; coordination with the City of Peoria's project to convert a portion of the downtown street network from one-way to two-way traffic; and coordination with an active railroad beneath the structure.

**Items 5:** The project has a completion date of November 17, 2023 plus 15 working days to complete punch list items, landscape work, and parking lot restoration. The completion date is based on an expedited work schedule.

**Item 6:** The time required to complete the project extends beyond the expiration of one or more existing collective bargaining agreements covering trades likely to be involved in the project. The trades that will be used on this project include but are not limited to those listed below. Trade contracts expiring prior to the anticipated construction completion date are indicated with bold font.
