

- 21. IT SHALL BE CONTRACTOR'S RESPONSIBILITY TO VERIFY ALL DIMENSIONS AND CONDITIONS EXISTING IN THE FIELD AT THE JOB SITE PRIOR TO BIDDING ON THE PROJECT AND PRIOR TO ORDERING MATERIALS AND COMMENCEMENT OF CONSTRUCTION, IF THERE ARE ANY DISCREPANCIES FROM WHAT IS SHOWN ON THE CONSTRUCTION PLANS. - 8. MAKE ADJUSTMENTS TO THE SEDIMENTATION AND EROSION CONTROL PLAN AND METHODS, AS NEEDED, TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENDED PURPOSE
- ALL ADJACENT ROADWAYS MUST BE KEPT CLEAR OF DEBRIS, INSPECTED DAILY, AND CLEANED WHEN NECESSARY OR AS DETERMINED BY THE ENGINEER.
- 10. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL NOT CAUSE OR PERMIT THE DUMPING, DEPOSITING, DROPPING, THROWING, DISCARDING OF LEAVING OF CONSTRUCTION MATERIAL AND/OR DEBRIS UPON OR INTO ANY CHANNEL, DITCH, SWALE OR ANY OTHER TEMPORARY OR PERMANENT LOCATIONS MEANT TO CONVEY SITE DRAINAGE.
- 11. IF THE CONTRACTOR IS NOTIFIED BY THE ENGINEER OF AN EROSION AND SEDIMENT CONTROL DEFICIENCY, THE

MAINTENANCE OF TRAFFIC NOTES

- EMERGENCY VEHICLE ACCESS SHALL BE MAINTAINED AT ALL TIMES. ANY SIGNIFICANT CHANGE IN TRAFFIC CONTROL SHALL HAVE PRIOR APPROVAL BY THE ENGINEER. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL PROVIDE A MINIMUM OF THREE (3) DAYS NOTICE IN ADVANCE OF CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES WHICH IMPACT EMERGENCY SERVICES




EXISTING TYPICAL SECTION CLAIRE COURT STA 35+00 TO STA 45+75








PROPOSED TYPICAL SECTION WEST FORK PARK STA 61+27 TO STA 65+73


