Justification for use of Project Labor Agreement (PLA) on Contract #64G63, Henry County

The use of a PLA on this project is consistent with all State and Local statutory and regulatory requirements

Item 2 This project is federally funded

Item 3 Estimated project cost is \$10,000,000

This project involves milling, pavement patching, and HMA surfacing

Any disruption in the continuity of this project due to labor issues would result in delayed deadlines that would cause safety concerns for the traveling public because of uneven lanes. Lapsing trade contracts during the project would be addressed through the use of a PLA. It is the illinois Department of Transportation's finding that the large skilled workforce needed for this project can be provided by the union trades involved and is a necessary requirement for a PLA.

Item 8 Any disruption to the contractor's schedule due to labor issues may result in the delay of the project completion date and lengthen the time for lane closures. This diversion of traffic, especially if left over the winter months, may contribute to additional exposure to crashes through the work zone due to the inherent risk of driver attention to lane changes and possible uneven lanes.
