## GENERAL NOTES

THIS SECTION SHALL BE CONSTRUCTED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PLANS; THE "STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS FOR ROAD AND BRIDGE CONSTRUCTION" ADOPTED JANUARY 1, 2012; AND THE SPECIAL PROVISIONS INCLUDED IN THE PROPOSAL.

THIS PROJECT IS LOCATED ON FAS ROUTE 1806 (IL 250) IN LAWRENCE COUNTY, FROM THE STREAM O. 7 MILES WEST OF BRIDGEPORT ROAD TO US BUSN 50 IN LAWRENCEVILLE. THE WORK INCLUDED IN SECTION (2, 2Z)RS-2, (2N) CONSISTS OF CONSTRUCTION OF A TURN LANE, PAVEMENT PATCHING, MILLING, HOT-MIX ASPHALT RESURFACING, AGGREGATE SHOULDERS, PAVEMENT MARKING, AND ANY OTHER WORK NECESSARY TO COMPLETE THE SECTION.

PAVEMENT MARKING SHALL BE APPLIED IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 78D OF THE STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS. SHORT TERM PAVEMENT MARKING SHALL BE APPLIED TO THE MILLED SUFFACE, BITUMINOUS MATERIALS (PRIME COAT), LEVELING BINDER AND HOT-MIX ASPHALT SUFFACE COURSE AS SPECIFIED IN SECTION 703 OF THE STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS. TEMPORARY TAPE SHALL BE USED ON THE SUFFACE COURSE AND PAINT SHALL BE USED ON MILLED SUFFACES.

THE TOTAL QUANTITY OF PAINT PAVEMENT MARKING-LINE 4" CONSISTS OF 38,728 FEET OF WHITE AND 13,560 FEET OF YELLOW.

THE TOTAL QUANTITY OF THERMOPLASTIC PAVEMENT MARKING-LINE 4" CONSISTS OF 7.056 FEET OF YELLOW.

THE TOTAL QUANTITY OF THERMOPLASTIC PAVEMENT MARKING-LINE 6" CONSISTS OF 530 FEET OF WHITE.

THE TOTAL QUANTITY OF THERMOPLASTIC PAVEMENT MARKING-LINE 12" CONSISTS OF 338 FEET OF WHITE.

## GENERAL NOTES (Cont'd)

THE TOTAL QUANTITY OF THERMOPLASTIC PAVEMENT MARKING-LINE 24" CONSISTS OF 26 FEET OF WHITE.

THE TOTAL QUANTITY OF RAISED REFLECTIVE PAVEMENT MARKERS CONSISTS OF 259 TWO-WAY AMBER MARKERS, 76 ONE-WAY AMBER MARKERS AND 14 ONE-WAY CRYSTAL MARKERS.

THE MATERIAL USED FOR AGGREGATE WEDGE SHOULDERS, TYPE B, AGGREGATE SHOULDERS, TYPE B, AND AGGREGATE SURFACE COURSE SHALL BE CRUSHED STONE OR CRUSHED CONCRETE.

THE EXISTING PAVEMENT SHALL BE PATCHED IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 442 OF THE STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS AND THE SPECIAL PROVISIONS. THE QUANTITY OF PATCHING SHOWN ON THE PLANS IS AN ESTIMATE ONLY AND THE FINAL LOCATIONS AND QUANTITY SHALL BE DETERMINED BY THE ENGINEER IN THE FIELD.

THE PAY ITEM TEMPORARY RAMP HAS BEEN INCLUDED FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF TEMPORARY RAMPS IN ACCORDANCE WITH ARTICLE 406.08 OF THE STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS. THE COST SHALL INCLUDE BOTH THE INSTALLATION AND THE REMOVAL OF THE TEMPORARY RAMPS.

THE RESIDENT ENGINEER SHALL BE THE SOLE JUDGE CONCERNING THE CURING TIME FOR THE VARIOUS HOT-MIX ASPHALT LIFTS.

VIBRATORY ROLLERS WILL NOT BE ALLOWED IN THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE HOT MIX ASPHALT SURFACE COURSE IN THE CITY LIMITS OF LAWRENCEVILLE, BUT ALL DENSITY REQUIREMENTS MUST BE MET ACCORDING TO THE STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS FOR ROAD AND BRIDGE CONSTRUCTION.

THE CONTRACTOR SHALL PROVIDE INTERNET ACCESSIBILITY TO THE HOT-MIX ASPHALT PLANT QUALITY CONTROL LAB SO THAT HOT-MIX ASPHALT PLANT REPORTS CAN BE E-MAILED TO THE DISTRICT HEADOUARTERS. THIS WORK SHALL BE INCLUDED IN THE COST OF ALL HOT-MIX ASPHALT ITEMS.

A UNIFORMLY STRAIGHT SAW CUT SHALL BE MADE AT LOCATIONS WHERE PROPOSED NEW CONSTRUCTION WILL ABUT EXISTING HOT-MIX ASPHALT SURFACES. THE SAW CUT SHALL BE MADE FULL DEPTH THROUGH THE EXISTING SURFACE. THIS WORK WILL BE CONSIDERED INCLUDED IN THE COST OF THE CONTRACT ITEMS INVOLVED AND NO EXTRA COMPENSATION WILL BE ALLOWED.

THE PAY ITEM HOT-MIX ASPHALT SURFACE REMOVAL 2 1/4" ASSUMES USING TWO PASSES TO ALLEVIATE THE 2" LANE DIFFERENTIAL.

THE MAILBOXES AT STA 149+97 RT SHALL BE RELOCATED TO THE PROPOSED MAILBOX TURNOUT AT STA 149+32 RT IN ACCORDANCE WITH 100T HIGHWAY STANDARD 406201. THE COST OF RELOCATIONS SHALL BE INCLUDED IN THE COST OF THE PROJECT.

THE LOCATIONS AND/OR DEPTHS OF UNDERGROUND UTILITIES SHOWN HAVE BEEN TAKEN FROM INFORMATION FURNISHED BY THE UTILITY OWNERS AND MUST BE CONSIDERED APPROXIMATE. FIELD MARKING OF FACILITIES IN CRITICAL AREAS MAY BE OBTAINED BY PROVIDING A MINIMUM OF 96 HOURS ADVANCED NOTICE THROUGH THE J.U.L.I.E. SYSTEM BY CALLING 800-892-0123.
