

REGISTRATION FEES

Effective Jan. 1, 1924

Fees for the Registration of Motor Vehicles of the First Division (Passenger cars carrying not more than 7 persons)

Table with 4 columns: Vehicle type, Year 1/2-Year, Year 1-Year, and Year 1 1/2-Year. Rows include Motor Bicycles, 25 H.P. and less, and 35 H.P. and more than 25 H.P.

Fees for the Registration of Motor Vehicles of the Second Division (Trucks, tractors and vehicles carrying more than 7 persons)

Table with 4 columns: Vehicle weight and load, Year 1/2-Year, Year 1-Year, and Year 1 1/2-Year. Rows include vehicles with gross weight of 5,000 lbs. and less, up to 20,000 lbs. and more.

Fees for the Registration of Trailers

Table with 4 columns: Trailer weight and load, Year 1/2-Year, Year 1-Year, and Year 1 1/2-Year. Rows include trailers with gross weight of 2,000 lbs. and less, up to 10,000 lbs. and more.

Fees for Registration as DEALER

Table with 4 columns: Dealer's License, Set of duplicate plates, Year 1/2-Year, and Year 1-Year.

Fees for Registration as CHAUFFEUR

Table with 4 columns: Fee for first registration as a chauffeur, Fee for renewal of chauffeur's license, Year 1/2-Year, and Year 1-Year.

FEES FOR DUPLICATES

Table with 4 columns: Duplicate motor vehicle license plate, Duplicate motor bicycle plate, Duplicate chauffeur's badge, Duplicate Certificate of Registration, Duplicate dealer's plates, Duplicate dealer's plate (lost), Duplicate trailer plate, Year 1/2-Year, and Year 1-Year.

SCHEDULE OF FEES

For Transferring Motor Vehicles of the Second Division (Trucks, tractors and vehicles carrying more than 7 persons)

Table with 4 columns: Horse Power of Vehicle Sold, Horse Power of Vehicle to which Number is to be Transferred, Jan. 1 to June 30, and July 1 to Dec. 31. Rows include vehicles with gross weight of 12,000 lbs. and more, up to 20,000 lbs. and more.

Fee of \$1.00 is required to transfer license numbers from motor vehicles of same horse power or weight or less from one motor bicycle to another.

Important Changes in Motor Vehicle Law

Application for a license must be made within 24 hours after purchase of vehicle. To retain same number, application and request must be filed 30 days before January 1st. Every person operating a motor vehicle equipped with electric headlights or headlights must dim, drop or extinguish them when within not less than two hundred fifty feet of a motor vehicle approaching in an opposite direction...

TO ILLINOIS MOTORISTS

- 1. As the State Executive charged with administration of the MOTOR VEHICLE LAWS of Illinois I bespeak the active CO-OPERATION of all MOTORISTS in our efforts to MINIMIZE DEATH and INJURY due to the operation of motor vehicles. 2. EXPERIENCE DEMONSTRATES beyond question that 90% of these unfortunate CASUALTIES ARE PREVENTABLE by (a) COMPLIANCE with the LAW, especially with respect to SPEED; (b) EXERCISE of CARE by all concerned, including pedestrians; (c) LITERAL COMPLIANCE with the ADMONITION to STOP, LOOK and LISTEN at ALL railroad CROSSINGS.

- (d) PRACTICE of ordinary COURTESY of the ROAD; (e) EXHIBITING TOWARD OTHER MOTORISTS and PEDESTRIANS the same REGARD as you EXPECT THEM to EXHIBIT TOWARD YOU; (f) REMEMBERING that the CHILD can not be expected to exercise the same JUDGMENT as an adult when CROSSING the HIGHWAY or PLAYING in the STREET - YOU MUST THINK FOR HIM! CASUALTIES due to AUTOMOBILES have now reached ALARMING proportions and it is to the interest of the motorist as well as the great public of Illinois that an IMPROVEMENT be EFFECTED IMMEDIATELY.

4. In Cook County alone in 1922, 736 MEN, WOMEN and CHILDREN were KILLED in this manner and 248 of this number were CHILDREN under 16 years of age. 5. I propose, therefore, as a measure of co-operation with the Chicago Safety Council and other agencies concerned in this extremely important problem, THAT EVERY MOTORIST carrying an ILLINOIS EMBLEM RESOLVE that in 1924 he will be a SAFE DRIVER, profit by the advice herein, study the MOTOR VEHICLE LAWS of this State and thus DO his SHARE in CONSERVING THE LIVES and LIMBS of our PEOPLE. 6. Surely YOUR LIFE and the LIVES of THOSE RIDING WITH YOU are worth the small effort and time required to WARRANT SAFE DRIVING under ALL circumstances. 7. SAFETY FIRST is HUMANITARIAN - and IT PAYS!
