
Every person operating a mator vehicle equipped
with electric headlight or headlights must dim, drop
or extinguish them when within not less than two
hundred fifty feet of a motor vehicle approaching in
an opposite direction regardless of whether or not the
machine is equipped with so-called anti-glare lens or
dimming device.

Dealers can only use dealer's license plates on
machines operated for sales and demonstrating purposes only.

Law requiring garages to keep records of machines
held in their place of business for rental, storage, livery or repair is repealed.
