IF YOU ARE INVOLVED IN A TRAFFIC ACCIDENT:
STOP IMMEDIATELY-RENDER ALL POSSIBLE AID TO THE INJURED. REPORT TO THE ILLINOIS DIVISION OF HIGHWAYS, SPRINGFIELD, AS SOON AS POSSIBLE-IF ONE PERSON'S PROPERTY IS DAMAGED MORE THAN \$100, OR SOMEONE IS INJURED OR KILLED. DO THIS IN ADDITION TO ANY REPORTS REQUIRED BY LOCAL POLICE OR INSURANCE COMPANIES. YOU MUST REPORT EVEN THOUGH NO OTHER VEHICLE THAN YOUR OWN WAS INVOLVED. OBTAIN OFFICIAL ACCIDENT REPORT FORM FROM STATE HIGHWAY POLICE, LOCAL POLICE, HIGHWAY DISTRICT OFFICE, OR INSURANCE AGENT. YOUR REPORT WILL BE HELD CONFIDENTIAL, AND MAY NOT BE USED AS EVIDENCE IN ANY LAWSUIT.
If you damage a highway fixture or other property, notify the owner, giving your name and address and automobile license number. Report the accident to the Illinois Division of Highways, Springfield, as soon as possible-if one person's property is damaged more than \$100, or someone is injured or killed. Do this in addition to any reports required by local police or insurance companies. You must report even though no other vehicle than your own was involved. Obtain official accident report form from State Highway Police, local police, highway district office, or insurance agent. Your report will be held confidential, and may not be used as evidence in any lawsuit.

EXPRESSWAY INTERCHANGE IN CHICAGO

Eight years ago Illinois, along with the other states, began construction of the 41,000 mile System of Interstate and Defense highways. Completion of the System, scheduled for 1972, will enable motorists to travel from coast to coast and border to border without encountering a single stop light. Illinois now has more than 711 of its 1,585 mile allotment of Interstate highways open to traffic and expects to open an additional 100 miles during 1964.
