



INDEX TO CITIES AND VILLAGES. A multi-column index listing cities and villages in Illinois, including their names, county names, and population figures.

POINTS OF INTEREST. A list of colleges and universities across Illinois, including their names and locations.

LEGEND. A detailed key explaining the symbols and line styles used on the map to represent different types of roads, highways, and landmarks.

POPULATION OF CITIES AND VILLAGES. A table showing population ranges for various city sizes, from under 1,000 to over 100,000.

RECREATION AREAS. A table listing various state parks and recreation areas, including their names and locations.

STATE POLICE DISTRICT HEADQUARTERS. A table listing the headquarters for each of the 17 state police districts.

HIGHWAY DISTRICT OFFICES. A table listing the district offices for various Illinois highways.

MILEAGE DISTANCE CHART. A grid-based chart used to determine the distance between two towns by tracing their locations on the map.
