REPORT THE ACCIDENT TO THE ILLINOIS DIVISION OF HIGHWAYS, SPRINGFIELD, AS SOON AS POSSIBLE IF ONE PERSON'S PROPERTY WAS DAMAGED MORE THAN \$100, OR SOMEONE WAS INJURED OR KILLED. DO THIS IN ADDITION TO ANY REPORTS REQUIRED BY LOCAL POLICE OR INSURANCE COMPANIES. YOU MUST REPORT EVEN THOUGH NO OTHER VEHICLE THAN YOUR OWN WAS INVOLVED. OBTAIN OFFICIAL ACCIDENT REPORT FORMS FROM STATE HIGHWAY POLICE, LOCAL POLICE, HIGHWAY DISTRICT OFFICE, OR INSURANCE AGENT. YOUR STATE REPORT WILL BE CONFIDENTIAL, AND MAY NOT BE USED AS EVIDENCE IN ANY LAWSUIT.
