IT IS POSSIBLE THERE MAY BE OTHERS, THE EXISTENCE OF WHICH IS NOT PRESENTLY KNOWN OR SHOWN, IT IS THE CONTRACTOR'S RESPONSIBILITY TO DETERMINE THEIR EXISTENCE AND EXACT LOCATION AND TO AVOID DAMAGE THERETO. ILLINOIS LAW REQUIRES A MINIMUM 48-HOUR NOTICE TO ALL UTILITY COMPANIES BEFORE DIGGING, FIELD LOCATIONS OF UNDERGROUND FACILITIES MAY BE OBTAINED BY CALLING THE J.U.L.I.E. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL NOTIFY AND COOPERATE WITH THE OWNERS OF ANY SUCH FACILITY IN THEIR REMOVAL AND REARRANGEMENT OPERATIONS IN ORDER THAT THESE OPERATIONS AND THE CONSTRUCTION OF THIS PROJECT MAY PROGRESS IN A REASONABLE MANNER. - 6. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL STAGE ALL WORK IN SUCH A WAY AS TO MAINTAIN INGRESS AND EGRESS TO ALL ARUTTING PROPERTIES AT ALL TIMES DURING CONSTRUCTION
- 7. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL CONFINE ALL OPERATIONS TO THE CONSTRUCTION LIMITS LINE SHOWN ON THE PLANS. ANY AREA DISTURBED BEYOND THESE LIMITS SHALL BE RESTORED TO ITS ORIGINAL CONDITION AT THE
- 8. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL FERTILIZE, SEED AND MULCH ALL EARTH SURFACES DISTURBED BY CONSTRUCTION. THE COST OF FERTILIZING, SEEDING, AND WILLCHING EARTH SURFACE INSIDE THE LIMITS OF CONSTRUCTION SHALL BE PAID FOR ACCORDING TO PAY ITEMS LISTED ON THE SUMMARY OF QUANITIES SHEET. THE COST OF FERTILIZING, SEEDING, AND MULCHING EARTH SURFACES DISTURBED OUTSIDE THE LIMITS OF CONSTRUCTION SHALL BE PERFORMED AT THE CONTRACTOR'S EXPENSE SEE THE SEEDING SCHEDULE FOR ESTIMATED PLAN QUANTITIES

IF NOT SPECIFIED IN THE PLANS AS "REMOVAL AND DISPOSAL OF UNSUITABLE MATERIAL", THIS WORK WILL BE PAID FOR ACCORDING TO ARTICLE 109.04 OF THE "STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS FOR ROAD AND BRIDGE CONSTRUCTION."
- 10. ALL DRAINAGE STRUCTURES CONSTRUCTED, ADJUSTED OR RECONSTRUCTED UNDER THE CONTRACT, SHALL BE CLEANED OF ANY ACCUMULATION OF SILT, DEBRIS OR FOREIGN MATTER AT THE END OF EACH WORKING DAY AND AT THE TIME OF FINAL INSPECTION. THE COST OF THIS WORK WILL NOT BE PAID FOR SEPARATELY, BUT SHALL BE CONSIDERED AS INCLUDED IN THE CONTRACT UNIT PRICES BID FOR THE VARIOUS DRAINAGE STRUCTURE ITEMS INCLUDED IN THE CONTRACT.
- 11. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL NOTE THE LOCATION OF ALL MANHOLE AND VALVE YAULT FRAMES AND LIDS LOCATED WITHIN THE RESURFACING LIMITS. APPROPRIATE CARE SHALL BE TAKEN TO PROTECT THESE ITEMS DURING MILLING OPERATIONS.

- 92. ALL PATCHING ON THIS PROJECT SHALL BE COMPLETED BEFORE MILLING OPERATIONS BEGIN.
- 13. THE THICKNESS OF THE BITUMINOUS MIXTURE SHOWN ON THE PLANS IS THE NOMINAL THICKNESS, DEVIATIONS FROM THE NOMINAL THICKNESS WILL BE PERMITTED WHEN SUCH DEVIATIONS OCCUR DUE TO IRREGULARITIES IN THE EXISTING SURFACE OR BASE ON WHICH THE BITUMINOUS MIXTURE IS PLACED.
- 14. THE PAVEMENT MARKING LOCATIONS SHOWN IN THE PLANS ARE APPROXIMATE. PROPOSED CROSSWALKS AND STOP BARS SHALL BE ADJUSTED AS DIRECTED BY THE ENGINEER, IF NECESSARY, TO MATCH FIELD CONDITIONS.
- 15. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL APPLY SHORT-TERM PAVEMENT MARKINGS TO THE MILLED AND PRIMED ASPHALT SURFACES, AND THE CONTRACTOR SHALL APPLY TEMPORARY PAVEMENT MARKINGS AFTER THE APPLICATION OF THE ASPHALT SURFACE COURSE. A QUANTITY FOR SHORT-TERM AND TEMPORARY PAVEMENT MARKINGS EQUAL TO THE AMOUNT OF PERMANENT PAVEMENT MARKING TIMES THE NUMBER OF REQUIRED APPLICATIONS HAS BEI INCLUDED IN THE PLANS.
