



TYPICAL SPACING DETAIL FOR **CROSSWALKS AND STOP BARS** OPTION 1



TYPICAL SPACING DETAIL FOR **CROSSWALKS AND STOP BARS**



PAVEMENT MARKINGS AT RAILROAD-HIGHWAY GRADE CROSSING

MAY VARY ACCORDING TO LANE WIDTH.


ON MULTI-LANE ROADS, THE STOP LINES SHALL EXTEND ACROSS ALL APPROACH LANES AND SEPARATE RXR SYMBOLS SHALL BE PLACED ADJACENT TO EACH OTHER IN EACH LANE.



NOTE:

WHEN MILLING OPERATIONS PRODUCE A ROUNDED EDGE, THEN A SAW CUT SHALL BE USED TO MANUFACTURE A PERPENDICULAR EDGE AS SHOWN IN THE DETAIL. THE ENGINEER SHALL BE THE SOLE JUDGE CONCERNING THE USE OF THIS DETAIL
