



1. EXISTING CONDITIONS

NOTE: AT THE END OF EACH NIGHTLY SHIFT, THE CONTRACTOR SHALL SWEEP THE PAVEMENT SURFACE CLEAN, PLACE TEMPORARY PAVEMENT MARKING AND REMOVE TRAFFIC CONTROL.

> DRUMS SHALL NOT BE PLACED IN THE LANE WHICH IS OPEN TO TRAFFIC. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL USE ONE FOOT WIDE VERTICAL BARRICADES WITH STEADY BURN LIGHTS ALONG THE MILLING AND PAVING OPERATIONS. THE TYPE OF VERTICAL BARRICADES SHALL BE APPROVED IN WRITING BY THE ENGINEER PRIOR TO BEING USED ON THE PROJECT. DRUMS OR TYPE II BARRICADES SHALL BE USED TO DELINEATE ALL OPEN RAMPS THROUGH THE WORK ZONE.

WESTBOUND I-90 (KENNEDY EXPRESSWAY) WILL BE COMPLETED IN 2005. EASTBOUND I-90 WILL BE COMPLETED IN 2006.
