The removal of raised median, corrugated median, and islands on this project shall include the concrete surface removal, curb & gutter removal, and saw cuts for proposed curb & gutter in the new bituminous overlay. This work shall be included in the contract unit price per Square Foot for Median Removal.

The removal and disposal of metal pipes without headwalls will not be paid for separately, and shall be included in the contract unit price for Earth Excavation.

Pipe underdrain removal is provided in the plan quantities and shall only be used when the existing pipe underdrains interfere with the installation of the new pipe underdrains or as directed by the Engineer.

Delineators shall be installed as shown in Standard 635001, except that the post shall be rotated 180° and only metal-backed delineators shall be permitted.

Delineators shall be placed at the ends of approach guardrail terminal sections, and at each headwall or end section of AR Culverts. This work shall be included in the cost of EARTH EXCAVATION.

Permanent Survey Markers, Type II shall be cast-in-place as shown on Highway Standard 667101.

The Contractor shall submit to the Engineer a description of location, elevation, and coordinates for each permanent survey marker. The Engineer shall submit this information to the Survey Crew.
