

GENERAL NOTES

- 1) THE CONTRACTOR SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR PROTECTING UTILITY PROPERTY FROM CONSTRUCTION OPERATIONS AS OUTLINED IN ARTICLE 107.31 OF THE STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS. IT SHALL BE THE CONTRACTOR'S RESPONSIBILITY TO COORDINATE OPERATIONS WITH THE VARIOUS UTILITY COMPANIES. THE J.U.L.I.E. NUMBER IS 1-800-892-0123
- 2) WHERE SECTION OR SUBSECTION MONUMENTS ARE ENCOUNTERED, THE ENGINEER SHALL BE NOTIFIED BEFORE SUCH MONUMENTS ARE REMOVED. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL PROTECT AND CAREFULLY PRESERVE ALL PROPERTY MARKERS AND MONUMENTS UNTIL THE OWNER, AN AUTHORIZED SURVEYOR OR AGENT HAS WITNESSED OR OTHERWISE REFERENCED THEIR LOCATION.
- 3) ACCESS TO ALL ENTRANCES AND SIDEROADS SHALL BE MAINTAINED AT ALL TIMES.
- 4) ANY REFERENCE TO A STANDARD IN THESE PLANS SHALL BE INTERPRETED TO MEAN THE EDITION AS INDICATED BY THE SUB-NUMBERS LISTED IN THE INDEX OF SHEETS, OR THE COPY OF THE STANDARD INCLUDED IN THESE PLANS.
- 5) ALL STATION REFERENCES ARE TO THE ROADWAY CENTERLINE OR BASELINE.


